- Respect those in authority by supporting the curriculum and policies of the school and respectfully cooperating with teachers and the school administration in matters of discipline.
- Respect others by communicating to the teacher first about any concerns regarding my child; schedule appointments and promptly bring concerns to school attention to address potential problems at the onset.
- Instruct my child to lead a God-pleasing life by showing love and forgiveness toward others, instructing them to follow the school policies, and disciplining them as needed.
- Set positive Christian examples in my words and actions in front of all children, showing respect to the school staff and encouraging children to do the same.
- Set positive Christian examples in my values, including monitoring TV, music, clothes and activities for the well-being of my child; dress in accordance with school standards, especially when at school facilities or functions.
- Show respect for the learning process by being involved, ensuring my child's homework is completed, seeing that my child is punctual and attends school regularly, and attending parent/teacher conferences and school activities.
- Communicate honestly and openly with teachers and school administration, treating every person with the compassion, love, kindness, respect, and dignity that should be expected in all Christian relationships.
- Speak about the school honestly and constructively; refrain from intentional harm to the school or staff in any dialogue or media.

I recognize that failure to comply with these expected standards of conduct will subject the student/family to potential disciplinary action, up to and including immediate suspension or expulsion.
